New Zealand Certificates in English Language (NZCEL) Level 4 & 5



WHAT IS NZCEL?

1. A **16-week** course, *not a one-off test like IELTS, TOEFL, PTE, etc*
2. Gain a nationally recognised qualification issued by NZQA.
3. **NZCEL certificate** meets the English entry requirements for many vocational, undergraduate, and postgraduate offered at NZ universities, Polytechnics, and Private Higher Education Providers.

New Zealand Certificates in English Language (NZCEL) Level 4 & 5



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- **NZCEL Level 4:** IELTS 5.5 (*no band under 5.0*), PTE 42 (*no band under 36*), OR passes ICL's IEPT (Internal English Proficiency Test), OR other equivalent recognised by NZQA
- **NZCEL Level 5:** IELTS 6.0 (*no band under 5.5*), PTE 50 (*no band under 42*), OR passes ICL's IEPT (Internal English Proficiency Test), OR other equivalent recognised by NZQA

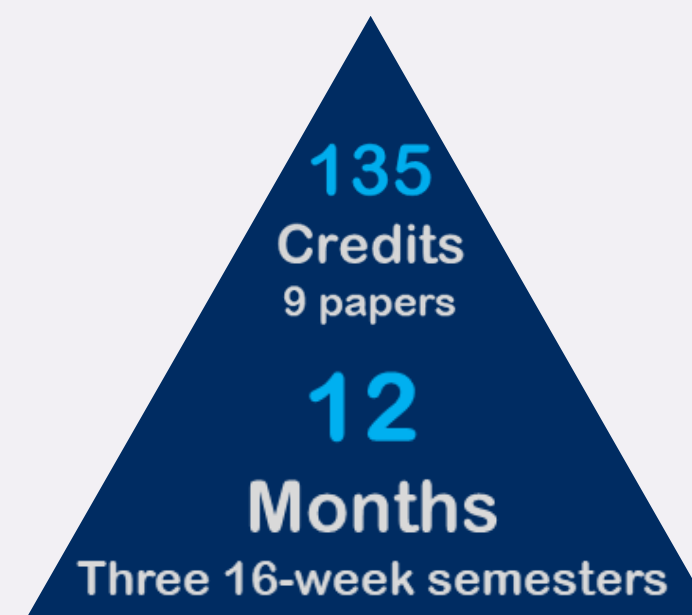

3. IELTS 6.0 (no band under 5.5), PTE 50 (no <42), NZCEL Level 4, or equivalent recognised by NZQA

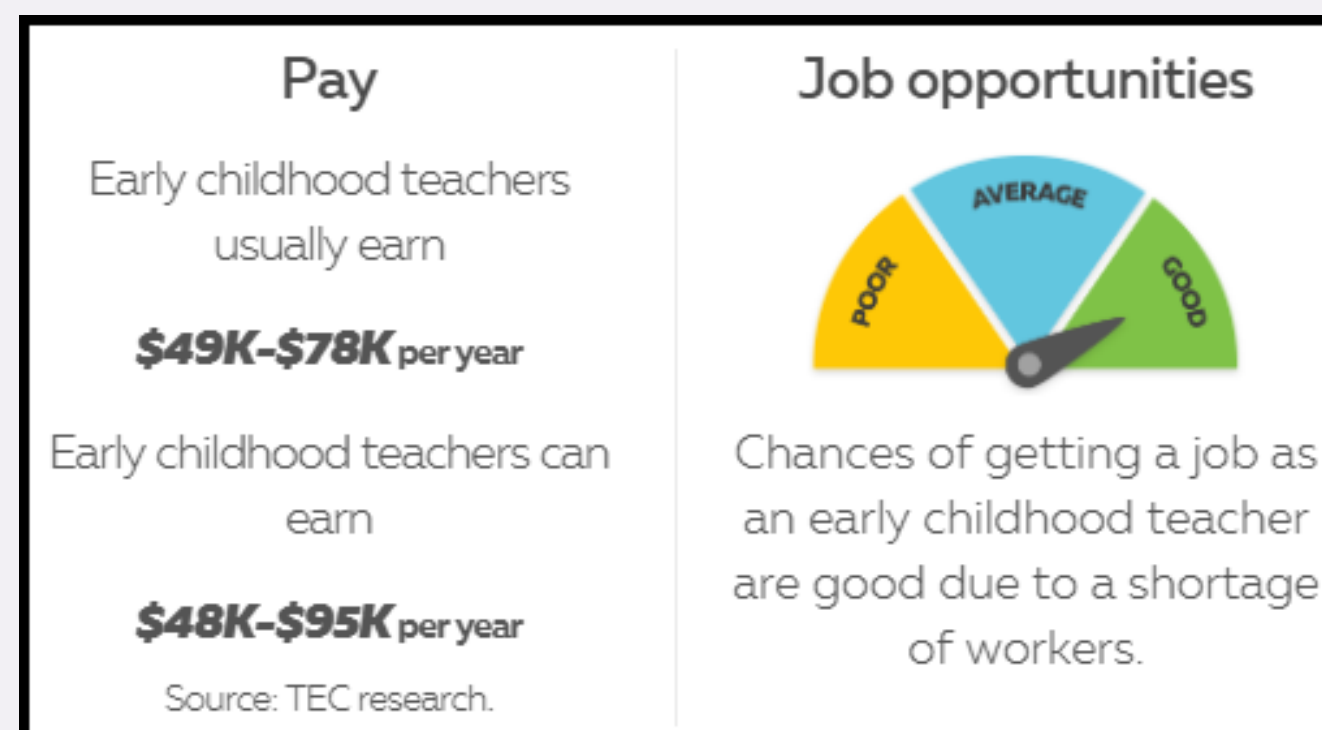
